**From the Brisbane** - follow the Warrego Highway to Toowoomba then the New England Highway towards Crows Nest. 7 kms north of Hampton, turn left onto Pechey MacLagan Road and travel a further 20 kms to Goombungee.  
**From the North** - at Esk, take the Esk-Hampton Road to Hampton, a distance of 42km, and turn right onto the New England Highway. (1) Refer above the directions from Hampton. (2) Follow the D'Aguilar Highway to Yarraman and turn left onto the New England Highway and follow through to Pechey MacLagan Road, approx. 10km south of Crows Nest, a distance of 80 kms. Turn right to Goombungee, a distance of 20 kms.

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## QCC PET POLICY

It is important to be aware that:

**Pet owners/carers are responsible for keeping their pets quiet at all times.**

**Barking dogs will not be tolerated as this can be disturbing to other members.**

Pets must be restrained and kept within the confines of the owner/carer's caravan/annex.

Pets are always to be kept on a short leash or other type of restraint.

When walking a Pet, it must be on a short leash or other type of restraint and be in the hands of a responsible adult.

Pets must not be off their leash anywhere on the rally site. (The only exception to this rule is if a specific area designated for this purpose is provided by the venue.)

Pets are not permitted in the following areas:

- where food is eaten,
- being prepared and/or served,
- toilets/shower facilities,
- the Hall or Meeting area or anywhere members gather for any social gatherings

Pet owners must clean up any mess their pet makes.

If you are attending a rally with a Pet, please advise the Rally Marshal on your arrival.
