MERRY CHRISTMAS



After spending most of September and October touring either before or after the National Rally it was great to be back to a normal club rally for November. Chinchilla as a venue was a new experience as it was our first time there, but it served us in good stead as this will be the venue of the 2026 state rally. The grounds are extensive, and the show society has spent a considerable sum installing power boxes and water outlets. There is a huge pavilion ideal for large gatherings which we chose not to use this rally, instead opting to use a smaller undercover building that afforded us shade and cool breezes during the heat of the days.

Wednesday & Thursday

These two days were low key this rally as Bev Green was absent and hence no card making. She was at home demonstrating our motto of "Fellowship on Wheels" as she supported Pat Barr through Graham's heart surgery at St Vincents Hospital. Many of us took the opportunity to investigate the Chinchilla surrounds taking trips out to the Chinchilla Weir where the local council has invested significant funds. The weir has always been a favoured 'free camp' site for travellers. This has been vastly improved with multiple powered sites (paid for by donation at the Information Centre in Chinchilla) and modern facilities including fire pits, new toilets and a children's playground. Another destination was the Cactoblastis Monument, 7km west of the town while in town many visited the Botanic gardens, the art gallery and the museum. The newly refurbished RSL paid host to groups from the club on most evenings.

Take the Bruce Hwy north from Brisbane. Take Exit 244 for Old Bruce Highway towards Imbil / Tourist Drive 42. Turn left on to Old Bruce Highway. 4.5 km. Turn left onto Kenilworth Skyring Creek Rd. 5.7 km Turn right onto Tuchekei Rd. 4.6 km. Turn left onto Mary Valley Rd / State Route 51. 4.5 km Turn right onto Brooloo Rd. 2.3 km Turn left onto Edward Street and it is 350 meters to the Showgrounds.

FIRES ALLOWED AT IMBIL

ON THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS.

- 1) You must comply with the requirements of the Local Council.
- 2) Fire bans are not in operation.
- 2) The fire must be in a metal container that is off the ground.
- 3) The fire must be in an area that is clear of any debris e.g. dry grass.
- 4) Members are to consider where the smoke might drift to.
- 5) The member lighting the fire is responsible for the fire control and extinguishment. QCC will not be liable for any damage caused by a fire lit by a member.
- 6) Members are responsible for the cleaning of the fire site including taking home all burnt materials and firewood.
- 7) Remember to locate your fire away from flammable hazards e.g. gas bottle.

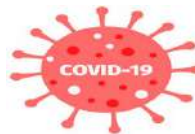
2025 CHRISTMAS CHARITY GIFT GIVING

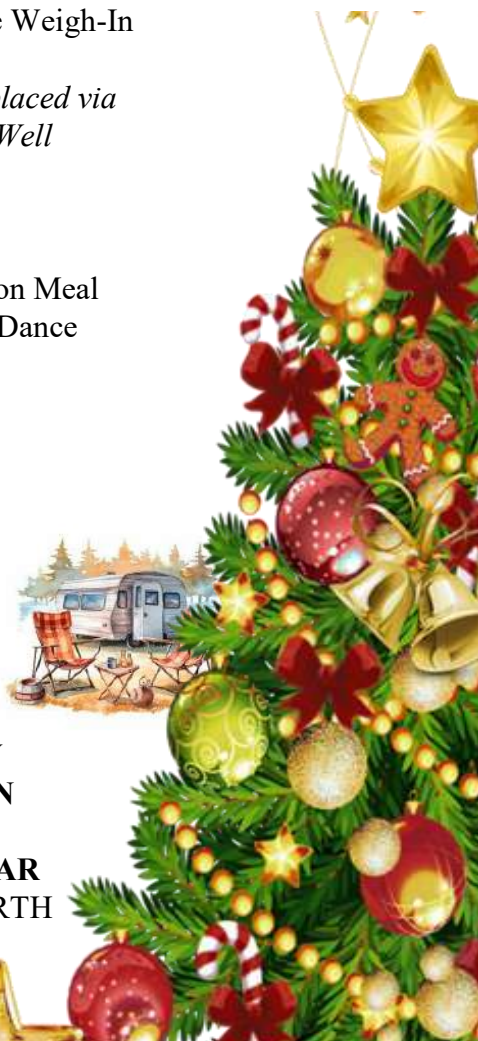

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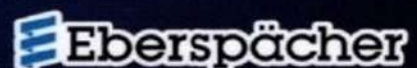
