North on Bruce Hwy. Take Exit 224 towards Eumundi-Noosa Rd/State Rte 12/Eumundi/Noosa Heads/Kenilworth/Tourist Drive 22. At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto W Eumundi Rd. This road becomes the Eumundi Kenilworth Road. Follow this road to Eumundi where the name of the road becomes Elizabeth Street as you enter Eumundi. Continue through town and showground is on the Left.

FIRES ALLOWED AT KENILWORTH ON THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS.
