PINE RIVERS SHOWGROUND

Since our original booking of the site in October 2025 the management of the grounds have changed hands.

What to expect when you arrive at the office which is open for arrivals from 12:00 noon until 4:30pm.

- When you arrive at the office your name will be checked off against our attendees list.
- You will be asked to sign a form. This indicates that your name, phone number, length of van and regos are correct.
- If you wish to have a key which will unlock the amenities and the front gate you may do so by paying a \$50 deposit.

Note: There are toilets available to access without a key. Showers require a key to access.

- The front gates are closed from 8:00 pm until 6:00 am.

If you wish to enter or exit the grounds when the gates are locked, you will need a key.

The Secretary will have a key

- If you are leaving on Sunday, hand your key to the Treasurer and you will receive your key deposit refund.
- If you are leaving on Monday, you will be able to attend the office and receive your key deposit refund.
- After signing in a staff member, on a golf cart, will take you to your site.
- Late checkout has been arranged for Sunday.
- What if you want to arrive before 12 noon?

There is a \$20 fee for early arrival and no guarantee that your site will be available. This is due to the mowing of the grounds that are taking place prior to 12 noon.

- What if you want to arrive after 4:30 p.m.?

Contact the rally marshal. He will know the number of the site that has been allocated to you and direct you to that site.

The next morning you would be required to attend the office and sign the paperwork to indicate that you have arrived and have the opportunity to access a key.

- Day visitors. - There is no charge for day visitors and there is a large carpark at the front of the grounds available to them.



WELCOME TO THE PINE RIVERS SHOWGROUNDS

The Pine Rivers Showgrounds are a privately owned Showgrounds run by the Pine Rivers A. H. & I. Association. We are dedicated to putting on the Annual Pine Rivers Show and serving the local community.

- Check in is 12:00 midday and 4:30pm Monday to Friday. On Saturday Check in is 12:00 until 2:30pm).
- Check out is before 11.00am.
- If you wish to check in early or check out late a \$20.00 fee is applicable to cover the costs associated with this. There is also a \$10.00 late check in fee.

Booking information

- Final guest numbers must be confirmed at least two weeks prior to your booking.
- We require one person to be the key representative/ contact for the club booking.
- Bookings remain tentative until the deposit is received.
- The deposit must be paid no later than one month prior to your arrival date.

Caravan Rules:

- 2 adults per site. All additional persons over the age of 12 will cost an additional \$5 each.
- A refundable \$50 key deposit is payable upon arrival. This will be returned in line with our check out.
- Rent payment is due on or before the due date.
- Maximum length of stay is 28 days, with a no return period of 21 days.
- Soft floor Camper trailers have a maximum stay of 7 nights
- Caravaners are not permitted to undertake repairs, maintenance, or modifications on their caravans while staying at the showgrounds.
- No Van or Car washing permitted.
- No Tents allowed.
- No Tarps or Mats allowed on the ground. A small door mat is permitted on your site (max 60cm x 60cm).
- Two vehicles are allowed to be parked within your allocated site, providing they fit.
- Power leads must be tagged. Before plugging in your power lead wrap it around the bar under the power box, and then feed lead through the hole and plug in.
- Noise is to be kept to a minimum. No amplified music after 10pm is allowed on your site.
- Sullage hoses must be moved daily. Any waste other than water is to be collected.
- Do not empty toilet waste in the amenities. Please use the Dump Points highlighted on the map.
- Management reserves the right to remove a van if necessary (e.g. if the maximum stay is exhausted, eviction).
- Please ensure grey water is not impeding on any sites. Please limit the amount of grey water where possible. No Kitchen waste or lint is to be left on the grounds.

Showgrounds Rules:

- Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult whilst on the grounds/using the amenities.
- 5kph Speed Limit is enforced on the grounds.
- Visitors, Children and Pets are not allowed near the Greyhound training track at the far end of the grounds.
- Please be aware CCTV is in use around the grounds.
- The showgrounds are a Multi-use facility, this will sometimes cause extra noise or changes to road use. Do not approach event personnel and please direct questions to the office.
- Pets must be kept on a leash or always confined. Pet droppings must be picked up immediately and placed in a skip bin. Pets are not allowed in the amenity blocks.
- The Camp Kitchen is a multi-use facility for our guests to enjoy. Please keep noise to a minimum after 10pm. Please always keep the BBQ and camp kitchen area clean and tidy.

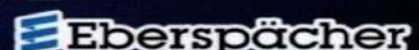
